AHEC Scholars Orientation, Immersion Weekend Sept 7-8	<p>Centers and RHP Programs were reminded that their narrative annual report is now due.</p> <p>NAHEC Scholars did have an opportunity to visit Tuba City. This year the immersive experience included a list of community organizations with addresses to visit, a scavenger hunt list, \$2.50 for lunch so that they could make food decisions based on the budget of a family receiving support from the supplemental nutrition assistance program (SNAP).</p> <p>SEAHEC Scholars included 10 students from UA and ASU and 8 students from 3 Mexico Universities. They completed a windshield tour at the border and then travelled across the border to get an overview of Mexico's health system. Scholars were able to participate in a mosquito clean-up with health workers throughout the community. During wrap-up scholars participated in songs, skits, and further discussions.</p> <p>CAAHEC Scholars had a successful experience reviewing community health center models and then had an opportunity to give back by creating care packages for community health workers and patients for a health fair.</p> <p>WAHEC Scholars included nine students who had an engaging rural America/border experience. Students were able to visit a homeless shelter and museum, attend RCBH and mental health care presentations.</p> <p>EAHEC Scholars included 13 students who participated in a bonding/ice breaker experience and participated in a community panel lunch discussion. Scholars were able to develop project ideas and 4 rotation requests have already been received for this area.</p> <p>It would be helpful to have a recorded session with information pertaining to project deadlines, executive summary, paper deadlines with an explanation of all the components/logistics that scholars need to consider.
