Immersion focused on Social Determinants of Health.</p> <p>WAHEC AHEC Scholars First day of Immersion occurred, but the second day has not occurred. The orientation part went well. In addition, Cocopah Nation offered additional information letting students know what is available. Joena Ezroj will notify scholars of Friday's immersion cancellation and future dates for day 2 of fall immersion experience.</p> <p>SEAHEC AHEC Scholars Immersion was a well-received experience. Students viewed a windshield tour of Willcox and Winchester Heights which included aerial views and drone views that helped students grasp the challenges and opportunities for the farming community.</p> <p>NAHEC AHEC Scholars Immersion included a well-rounded interprofessional group of students who were eager and energetic to learn. Immersion focused on bias and health quality discussion along with interactive activities addressing the health of American Indian, LatinX and Immigrant communities.
