You will be asked to identify the poster author(s) and their affiliated institution(s), topics among those listed above and the poster title. **Your abstract should not exceed 350 words and is due by 11 pm on Sunday, March 7, 2021.** If further information is needed, you will be contacted.

Poster Layout and Presentation

- Posters may not be larger than 48" (height) x 72" (length).
- A PDF of your poster is due by 11 pm on Sunday, March 21, 2021 in advance of the conference through the link above. This PDF will be displayed through an [online gallery](#).
- A video presentation, no longer than 3 minutes, of your poster may be included and should be uploaded at the above abstract and poster link. Posters submitted without a video presentation will be displayed on our website only.

Poster Presentations

Poster viewing will begin one week prior to the start of the conference and will be available on our [website](#). Virtual poster Q & A/break-out sessions will be offered at this year's conference; approximate times are listed on the [agenda](#). In break-out sessions, video presentations of posters will be shown and a moderated Q & A session will occur. If you wish to have your video poster presentation shown during a Q&A session you must register for a Q&A session and be online during the selected time to answer questions. On the registration form you will indicate which video presentation/Q&A session you wish to attend. If you are part of a group of students/professionals, that is doing a video presentation for your poster, as a group you must agree on the Poster Presentation Group session you will be attending. Your video poster presentation will only be shown once during the conference.

Poster Awards

Awards will be given for Outstanding and Excellent posters at the end of the conference.

Awards will be shared equally among all listed authors and co-authors, exclusive of faculty. Awards will be announced on April 10 at a time specified on the agenda.
